


- If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.

In case of failure or damaged power cord, stop use and ask the electrical technician.



Accumulated dust may cause fire.



**Securely insert the ground prong.
Ask the electrical technician for a new socket.**



Wipe the power plug periodically.



Use a socket appropriate for this appliance.



Keep away from flammable materials.



- The plug shape, socket shape and rating requirement vary with the region.

May cause failure

Do not disassemble, repair or modify it by yourself.



When using the "Panasonic SmartApp+" app

(Cause of malfunction due to radio waves from the appliance)

- Keep at least 15 cm away from the mounting part of the cardiac pacemaker.
- Keep away from medical equipment and automatic control equipment (automatic doors, fire alarms, etc.).

Safety Precautions (continued)



WARNING

May cause fire (For safety use of the dryer)

Do not dry items soiled with flammable materials.



- Items that have been soiled with substances such as cooking oil, acetone, alcohol, petrol, kerosene, spot removers, turpentine, waxes, wax removers and cosmetic oils must not be dried in the appliance even after having been washed.

Empty all pockets.



- Make sure that no objects are left in any of the pockets. Pay particular attention to cigarette lighters and matches. They may cause fire.

Do not dry items made of rubber, etc.



- Items such as foam rubber (latex foam), shower caps, waterproof textiles, airtight fabrics, rubber backed articles and clothes or pillows fitted with foam rubber pads should not be dried in the appliance. Such materials may be destroyed and thereby damage the appliance.
- Do not dry unwashed items in the appliance.

The lint must not be allowed to accumulate around the appliance.



Observe the following.


- Never stop the appliance before the end of the drying cycle unless all items are quickly removed and spread out so that the heat is dissipated.
- The appliance is not to be used if industrial chemicals have been used for cleaning.
- The appliance must not be supplied through an external switching device, such as a timer, or connected to a circuit that is regularly switched on and off by a utility.



CAUTION

May cause water leakage

Turn off the water faucet.



Use new hose-sets.




- New hose-sets supplied with the appliance are to be used and old hose-sets should not be reused.


Be careful not to get your fingers caught.




Do not climb on the appliance.




Keep away from heat and direct sunlight.



Remove anchor bolts before operation.




Do not obstruct.

 - staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
 - farm houses;
 - by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments;
 - bed and breakfast type environments;
 - areas for communal use in blocks of flats or in laundrettes.

Do not wash excessively oily clothes.





Touch operation

- If water, detergent or softener gets on, turn off and wipe off with a towel etc. immediately. (Cause of malfunction)



Control buttons



NOTE

- Turn off → back on
- No operation → auto power off
- In case of a power failure
 → When the power recovers, operation resumes from where it stopped. (Auto Restart)



Detergent

- Follow the instructions on each package.

Detergent

Use a low foam detergent.

- To prevent powder detergent from remaining in the detergent drawer:



Bleach

Whiten bleach
(chlorine bleach)



Manual Detergent tank

Powder detergent

Liquid detergent








NOTE

- Close detergent drawer completely before use to prevent water leakage.





Auto Dose tank



NOTE

- Liquid detergent/softener left for a long time may clump or solidify. In that case, clean detergent drawer. (P. 34)



Do not use separated or solidified detergent/softener

When adding detergent/softener, the window turns from black to pink (softener) and blue (detergent). Add detergent/softener when the window appears black.




Auto Dose

Detergent and softener will be automatically added depending on the amount of laundry and dose amount setting, available with all programs except "Tub Hygiene" and "Dry Assist (Dry only)".

■ To supply detergent / softener



- Pull the drawer out.



Softener
Max. 450 ml

Liquid detergent
Max. 750 ml

- 3 Close tank lid and push the drawer in completely



■ To set "Auto Dose" function



■ Standard amount

- Dry cloth: 4 kg
- Liquid detergent: 30 ml
- Softener: 30 ml

■ To change the dose amount



- Range value
 - Detergent: 6 ml - 60 ml
 - Softener: 6 ml - 81 ml
 - Step change: 3 ml
- (The setting is memorized.)



(NOTE)

- If there is water in the tub before, detergent and softener will not be automatically supplied when washing.
- When the ambient temperature is low, operation time may be longer because the detergent/softener may solidify.
